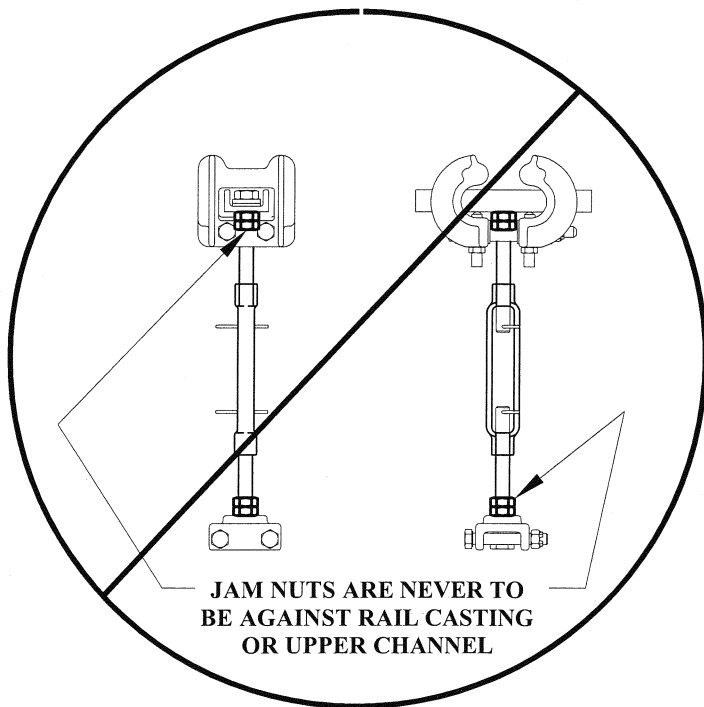

It has recently come to our attention, that some installation companies, not under our supervision, have incorrectly installed the Unified 586/590 & 586/490 threaded rod hanger assemblies. A visual inspection is all that is needed to determine if jam nuts on the threaded rod portion of the hanger have been tightened correctly. **The attached sketch illustrates the correct and incorrect tightening procedure. See below:**

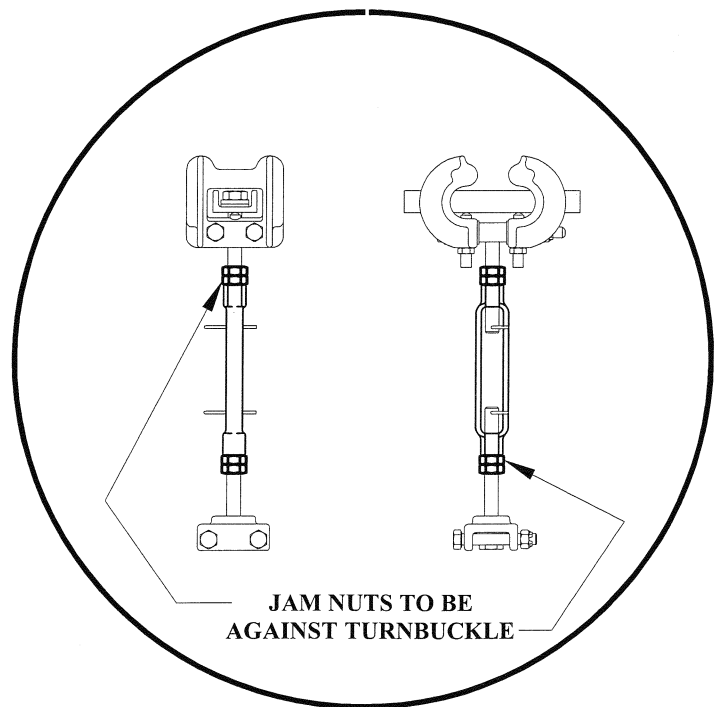
As an added measure of safety, Unified Industries, Inc. always recommends that each hanger location be secured with safety cable. This cable should be **non-coated wire rope** secured with Crosby type clamps and fixed to the runway rail and structural joining member. Unified Industries, Inc. also recommends the above inspection be added to or established as regular preventive maintenance.

Incorrect installation of any hanger rod assemblies could result in rod failure and compromise the safety of your personnel. If you have any questions or are not sure if you are affected by this, please call our Sales or Engineering Departments at 517 546-3220.
